Strategy Employed by Cassius	Example from His Pitch to Brutus
flattering Brutus	lines 55–62: "And it is very much lamented, Brutus, that you have no such mirrors as will turn your hidden worthiness into your eye that you might see your shadow..."
smearing Caesar	lines 128–131: "Ye gods! It doth amaze me, a man of such a feeble temper should so get the start of the majestic world, and bear the palm alone."
